This is <u>not</u> a solicitation from a lawyer. www.Imagine360DataSettlement.com 1-888-836-1042 A \$475,000.00 settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit against Imagine360, LLC ("Defendant") – a vendor for employee health plans - arising out of a Data Incident that occurred on or around January 30, 2023. The Defendant detected unauthorized access to Private Information of individuals that obtained health insurance-related services through Defendant. The Private Information involved in the Data Incident includes personally identifiable including names, medical information, health insurance information, and Social Security numbers ("Private Information").

Who is Included? Records show you are a member of the Settlement Class, defined as: All living individuals residing in the United States who received notice of the Data Incident indicating their Private Information may have been impacted in the Data Incident.

What does the Settlement Provide? As a Settlement Class member, you can file a Claim Form online or by mail postmarked by July 31, 2025, for the following Settlement Class Member Benefits:

<u>Cash Payment A – Documented Losses:</u> You may submit a Claim Form and provide reasonable documentation for losses related to the Data Incident for up to \$5,000.00 per Settlement Class Member. **OR** 

<u>Cash Payment B - Flat Cash</u>: Instead of Cash Payment A, without having to provide documentation, you may submit a Claim Form to receive a flat cash payment in an estimated amount of \$75.00. **AND/OR** 

<u>Credit Monitoring</u>: In addition to Cash Payment A *or* Cash Payment B, you may also submit a Claim Form to receive three years of free Credit Monitoring.

Injunctive Relief: Defendant is implementing additional security measures following the Data Incident.

Your Cash Payment may be subject to a *pro rata* (a legal term meaning equal share) adjustment up or down in amount. For more information, visit www.Imagine360DataSettlement.com and read either the Settlement Agreement or the Long Form Notice.

Other Options. If you do not want to be legally bound by the Settlement, you must opt-out of the Settlement and your request must be postmarked by July 16, 2025. If you do not opt-out, you will give up the right to sue and will release the Defendant and Released Parties from the claims in this lawsuit. If you do not opt-out, you may object to the Settlement by July 16, 2025. The Long Form Notice on the Settlement Website explains how to opt-out or object. If you do nothing, you will get no Settlement benefits, and you will be bound by the Settlement and any judgments and orders. The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing on August 15, 2025, to consider whether to approve the Settlement, Class Counsel's attorneys' fees of up to 35% of the Settlement Fund and costs, and any objections. You or your lawyer may attend and ask to appear at the hearing, but you are not required to do so.
